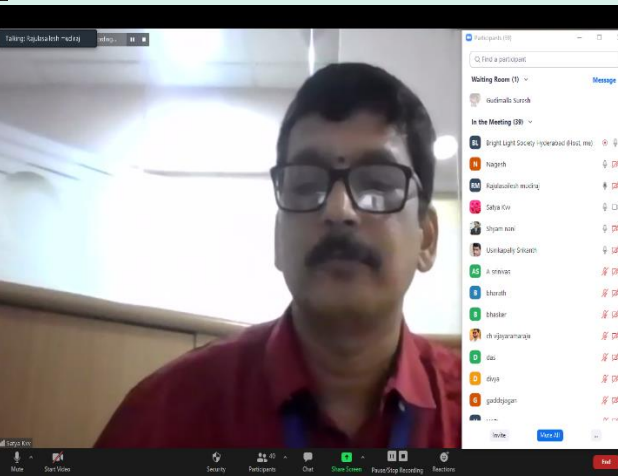
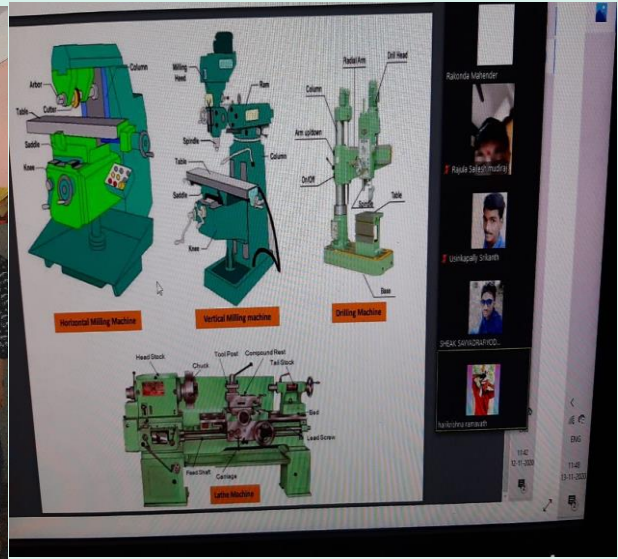
IMPACTING THE LIVELIHOOD OF ONE MILLION PEOPLE BY 2025

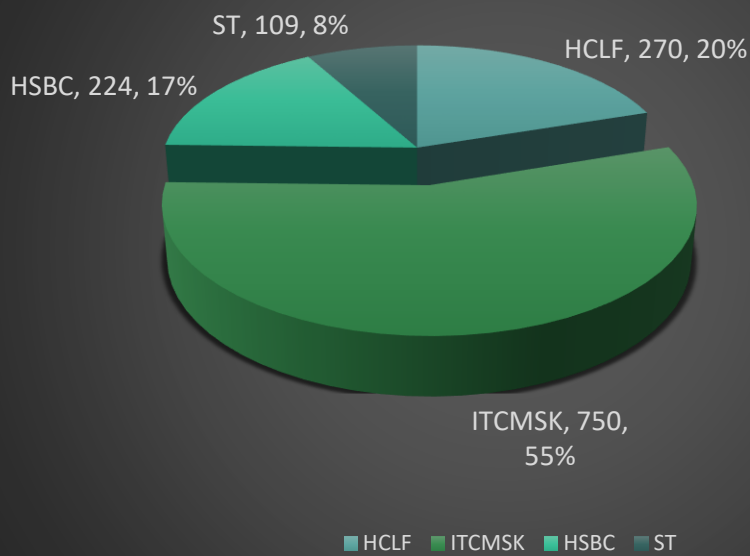

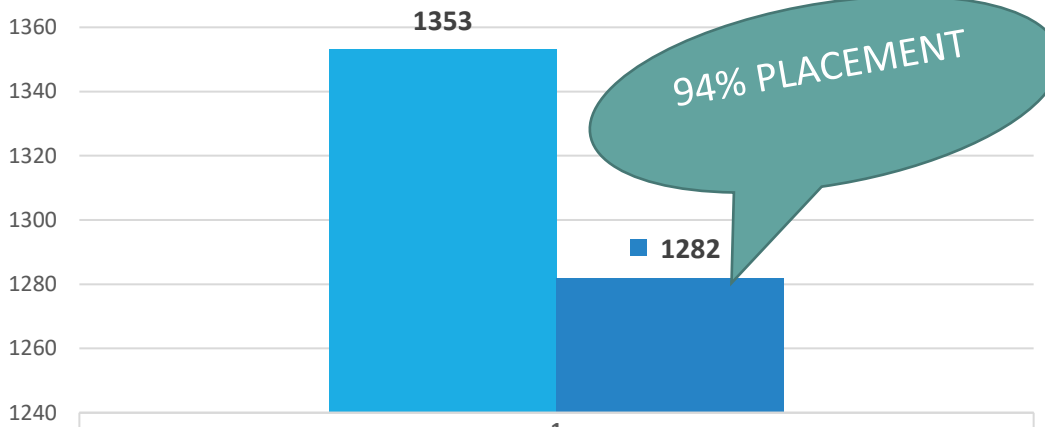
